Q. You seem to be right in the middle of guys about to finish, you've got guys that are done, you've got some that have eight holes to go. Does anybody have an advantage when it comes to who's played how many holes and tomorrow?

GLEN DAY: We're all sitting around. I mean, we're all sitting around. The only person who has an advantage is if you're finished, then you can go back to the hotel and relax, that's about it.

Q. So you're 7 under. You had quite the last couple holes. Take us through what's going on so far.

GLEN DAY: You know, I got some good breaks. Like I said, I've got real lucky. I hit a couple of bad shots that stayed in play and I've made some huge putts. I mean, three really long putts. So when you make long putts and you get a good break, you should have a good round.

Q. This tournament tends to be 18, 19, 20 under par as the winner. Is it got to keep on making birdies?

GLEN DAY: Oh, yeah. Hey, we're just getting started if we're going to play four rounds. Now, if we want to call the tournament right now, I'm all for it. I mean, we'll call it right now. But if we get in four rounds, yes, there will be a lot of birdies made. Plus with the weather that is coming in, the golf course will be soft, the greens will be holding. They just firmed up a little bit and they've gotten really good. So, you know, I think the scores will go way low.
