Q. What did you do well today?

KEN DUKE: Well, on a golf course like this, when it gets firm and fast, you just have to keep it in front of you. You really have to use your imagination going into the greens because they're so firm and fast, so you've got to keep the ball below the hole, for sure. All of us today in our group, we got behind the hole a few times and we paid for it. So just hit it close a couple times and got through the day.

Q. Talk a little bit, I guess, about the golf course. I know I was just talking to Goydos and this is a distinctive place, that's what I'm picking up.

KEN DUKE: Yeah, it's a tree lined place, so obviously the defense is the wind and obviously yesterday we had a ton of wind. Today I played good, but yesterday I probably played better just because I controlled my ball in that wind and got around and didn't shoot way over par and got behind. So on a golf course like this, you've got to have some wind for the defense or these guys will shoot some good scores.
