WES SHORT, JR. (-9)

WES SHORT: You know, I'm probably going to be in the last group tomorrow it looks like, so got a chance to win the tournament. That's all you want going into the last day.

Q. Was there a moment where the weather played a role for you? Obviously not, it seems.

WES SHORT: I'll tell you what, when we started out it looked like it was going to be miserable all day, but I guess about the fourth hole it started kind of letting up. Then actually the sun came out for a little bit and we got all the conditions I think that this course can offer.

Q. Seems like a lot of people are having a tough time on this 18th hole. Just your thoughts on the greens here?

WES SHORT: You know, the greens are in great shape. This is a tough little hole to come in at. Like I hit a hybrid in there, it's not like a short club. That water, you don't want to go right.

Q. Can you describe what it's like to be in the last group on a Sunday? Like you said, that's what everyone's kind of doing this for?

WES SHORT: It means you should be playing pretty well, so hopefully, you know, get to see what's going on just right in front of you. Hopefully tomorrow I can play -- drive it better and hold that trophy.

Q. If my memory serves, you've had a pretty good Sunday in Canada before, haven't you?

WES SHORT: I've had a couple of them. I've played -- actually, I played pretty good the year Fred won here and then in Quebec played real well and won in Quebec my rookie year.

Q. And that was the same year, right?

WES SHORT: It was.

Q. Do you feel pretty comfortable on this course?

WES SHORT: I like the course, it suits me well. If you drive it good here, you can play good here. I usually drive it good. I've been struggling a little bit, but I'm keeping it where I can hit it again.

Q. Do you think you treat these opportunities any differently? You were a long time until you got on the PGA TOUR, I know you played in your first U.S. Open I think a couple years ago.

WES SHORT: Yeah.

Q. Do you treat it any differently being in the mix to win a high-level event like this?

WES SHORT: No. You've got to just, like they always say, play one shot at a time. I can't control anybody else, can only control myself.
