Q. What do you like about playing on this tour as opposed to maybe the PGA or wherever?

**VIJAY SINGH:** It's a lot more relaxed. It's three days, you can ride a cart if you want and no cut. Just fun.

Q. You still play quite a bit on the PGA TOUR, I think you finished sixth or were in contention. Do you like honing your skills against those guys? You think you can beat them? It would make you the oldest player ever.

**VIJAY SINGH:** I've been playing a lot. This year has been -- you know, I've been injured quite a bit, so I haven't been able to go out there and actually play well. You know, if my body's good and I'm playing well, sure, I can compete out there. But if I'm not playing well and if the body's not working, might as well just stay out here.
