Q. Got to be happy with the start in the first round?

WOODY AUSTIN: Oh, yeah, absolutely. Didn't really play as well as I've been playing. My short game was really good today, really got it up and down real well today.

Q. How important, too, is it this late in the season, kind of the push the last few events?

WOODY AUSTIN: Yeah. I mean, you want to be in that top 10 for sure going into the Playoffs so that you have a legitimate shot. Scott's so far in front, so you'd better make sure you're at least in the top 10 with a chance to win one of those to get close to him. It's very important.

Q. How much do you still enjoy coming back to this place?

WOODY AUSTIN: Well, obviously it's only our second year back, but yeah, it is nice. I mean, I had some -- obviously I won the first year, but I also had some good finishes after that. It was always a great place for me to come back, so I'm happy to be back.

Q. I know obviously the back nine you didn't do as well as the front today, struggled a little bit, but how do you maybe learn from that heading into tomorrow?

WOODY AUSTIN: Well, again, I just didn't hit it as good today. I think I wasted it yesterday in the pro-am because I played really good in the pro-am yesterday. I mean, that's the way it goes. But the greatest thing about it is my short game was so solid today, I never even -- even though I missed greens, I never even had a putt for par. I almost chipped in four times. I chipped it like this (indicating) three times. So it was pretty impressive.
