That's one thing I did today, I drove it pretty well. I'm not like saying 70's bad, but I needed to be a shot lower.

Q. To finish the day with that sand shot like you did, I mean how nice is that?

FRED COUPLES: Well, it made it much easier than hitting it out there four feet and trying to make a little curling putt. You know, the whole course was good. We were so-so today, our whole group. Cabrera holed a beautiful pitch shot for eagle and Paul and I really didn't do a whole lot, but sometimes that helps. McCarron and Goosen are going nuts. We couldn't do anything together, but we had a good time. It was fun to see Cabrera. I think it's his first tournament and he's one of my not best buddies, but he's a fan favorite. He can really play. He'll do just fine out here.
