Today – Hot conditions with increasing Monsoonal moisture lifting into the region. Cloud cover will be much more prevalent today and could keep temperatures from reaching the century mark. Scattered T-storms likely develop over eastern Oregon this afternoon and will approach the area after 6pm. Gusty outflow winds are the main concern, however there is also low risk for lightning. Otherwise, light southeast winds this morning become more erratic by the afternoon. **Sunrise: 6:51am / Sunset: 8:45pm**

Tomorrow – Very strong upper level ridging and slightly less cloud cover will lead to very hot temperatures on Monday with a new record high likely being set. Northwest winds will be in place with some gusts near 15 mph by late afternoon. An isolated T-storm could approach the Boise area, mainly during the evening hours. Again, gusty outflow winds are the main concern.
