**Extended Forecast** – An upper level low will begin to approach the area late tonight into tomorrow. Some shower activity could develop tonight, otherwise the main threat will be between 9am-3pm Saturday. Rainfall could be heavy, however the threat for lightning is low. Localized rainfall amounts may approach 1.00" in some areas. A few showers could linger into Sunday morning as the main upper level energy pass through, otherwise much needed drier conditions will filter across the area.
