Extended Forecast – Shower threat ends this evening with cloudy conditions continuing tonight into Friday morning. Dry conditions should remain in place through the day Friday, with some peeks of the sun finally possible during the afternoon. A front arrives on Saturday with a period of showers and T-storms possible, with highest chances for precipitation favoring the afternoon hours. Sunshine will finally return on Sunday. Wind direction will change each round, however speeds will remain relatively the same with gusts of 15-20 mph possible at times.
