







# Korn Ferry Challenge at TPC Sawgrass

## 6am Weather Forecast




**Today** – Afternoon shower and thunderstorm chances decrease over TPC Sawgrass today as drier air develops across coastal areas of north Florida. That being said, thunderstorms are expected across interior areas of north Florida, which may be noticeable on radar. A low risk exists for these interior thunderstorms to drift back near the course during the early evening.

**Extended forecast** – The highest thunderstorm chances this weekend will occur during the early afternoon (prior to 3pm) with the eastern sea breeze expected to push thunderstorms west of TPC Sawgrass towards interior north FL after 3pm. Additionally, an isolated shower can't be ruled out Saturday and Sunday morning but is expected to be brief and light to moderate in intensity. Temperatures will start out in the low 70s each morning and warm into the mid 80s each afternoon.
