







Korn Ferry Challenge at TPC Sawgrass

Extended forecast – Friday, chances for afternoon showers and thunderstorms decrease slightly over TPC Sawgrass due to drier air moving into coastal areas of north Florida, however interior areas of north Florida may continue to see slow moving scattered showers and thunderstorms. Thunderstorm chances increase again this weekend with increased moisture returning. Temperatures will start out in the low 70s each morning and warm into the mid to upper 80s each afternoon.
