**Extended forecast** – Saturday, drier conditions build in as a light west breeze in the morning turns northwest for the afternoon. A low chance of an isolated shower/t-storm does still exist Saturday afternoon, but most areas remain dry. Winds Saturday will be northwesterly, with gusts to 15 mph from 11am-5pm. Sunday, a system passing by to the south may bring a few showers up into this area during the day. Winds will be light from the east.
