Today – A few showers/t-storms are expected in the area today, highest chances from 11am-6pm. Locally heavy downpours will be possible with these cells. Drier conditions build back in for tonight. Winds will be light from the southwest, reaching 5-12 mph in the afternoon. Highs will be near 90F this afternoon.

Peak Heat Index: 98-100F. Rainfall: 0.10-0.25", isolated 0.50" with storms.

Extended forecast – Friday, the remnants of Hurricane Laura approach the area with increasing chances for showers/t-storms during the day, highest chance after 2pm Friday and through the evening. Locally heavy rain will be a threat with this, with 1-2" of rain expected Friday-Friday night. Saturday, drier conditions build in, but some isolated shower/t-storm activity may redevelop in the afternoon. Winds will turn out of the northwest Saturday, with gusts to 15-20 mph. Sunday, dry conditions are expected with lower humidity and a light east-northeast breeze.
