






**Extended Forecast** – High pressure remains in place on Saturday with dry conditions. A complex of showers/T-storms likely develop over Iowa Saturday night and track into northern Illinois Sunday morning. Precipitation can't be completely ruled out near the Springfield area, however it appears most of this activity stays to our north. Strong winds are expected during the day Sunday with gusts possibly exceeding 25 mph. In Chicago, a strong and slow-moving cold front likely brings a period of unsettled weather Monday through Wednesday. Rainfall amounts could exceed 1 inch during this period.
