Today – Large complex of T-storms to our north will continue to track eastward this morning. The southern edge of this complex could come within 25-50 miles of the golf course between 8-11am. Otherwise, skies will gradually clear with dry and windy conditions expected this afternoon. Wind gusts of 20-30 mph will become likely with some gusts approaching 35 mph after 3pm. Temperatures are expected to reach the upper 80s this afternoon. **Sunrise: 6:32am / Sunset: 7:20pm**

Extended Forecast – A cold front will move into the Chicago area tonight and then become stalled out near the area on Monday. This front will likely remain over the region through Thursday with periods of rain and storms. The heaviest periods of rain favor Monday night into Tuesday morning and on Thursday. While the heaviest axis of rain (2-4") appears to setup to the northwest of Chicago, 1-2" will still be possible through the day Friday. Seasonally cool temperatures and blustery north-northeast winds are expected throughout the week.
