Today – Some patchy fog before 8am, otherwise mostly sunny skies will be in place much of today with temperatures climbing into the upper 80s. A cold front will move through between 3-6pm this afternoon. While a few showers could develop along this front, development will remain sparse. The threat for lightning is low. Gusty southwest winds will develop with gusts of 20-25 mph likely by mid-day. Winds shift to the northwest behind the front. **Sunrise: 6:29am / Sunset: 7:25pm**

Extended Forecast – High pressure will be in place Friday and Saturday with comfortable temperatures and dry conditions. A disturbance will track across the region late Saturday night into Sunday with a complex of showers/T-storms likely developing over Iowa and moving into northern Illinois Sunday morning. The highest threat for precipitation remains to our north, however some activity could reach Springfield Sunday morning. Gusty southwest winds are possible on Sunday with gusts in the 20-25 mph. Higher gusts could occur but confidence in anything over 25 mph is low.
