**Today** – Upper level energy over Tennessee will lift northward today and bring the chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms late this afternoon into the evening hours. Storms will be slow moving and could produce heavy rainfall in a short period of time. Otherwise partly to mostly cloudy skies can be expected with highs in the mid 80s. The wind will remain light and variable averaging 3-6 mph.

**Extended Forecast** – Weakening upper level energy will be over the Ohio Valley on Sunday before shifting east.
