

Today - Another cool start this morning with temperatures in the mid 50s. Otherwise sunny skies can be expected today with high clouds streaming across the area this afternoon making for partly cloudy skies at times. Temperatures should warm into the low 80 s with a light wind out of the northeast 4-8 mph.

Extended forecast - Warmer and more humid conditions return Friday into the weekend with highs in the mid 80s. An upper level low pressure system will move north from the gulf states and provide higher instability late in the day Friday through the weekend. Can't rule out an isolated t-storm developing Friday evening with showers and thunderstorms becoming more likely by Saturday afternoon as the system moves overhead. Showers and storms will be slow moving and could produce heavy rainfall in a short period of time. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be possible again Sunday afternoon.
