**Today** – Some light, shallow fog is possible before 8am, otherwise partly cloudy skies can be expected the rest of the day. **Extended Forecast** – Hurricane Delta is expected to make landfall along the Gulf Coast Friday with the remnants tracking northeastward through the Southeast U.S this weekend. Moisture will begin to return on Friday and especially for Saturday and Sunday. This will bring higher rain chances to the area with scattered showers/T-storms possible each afternoon. Temperatures will climb into the lower 90s each day. Southeasterly winds at 7-14 mph are expected Friday and Saturday. Winds should switch to the southwest on Sunday.
