


Panama Championship 7am Weather Forecast Saturday, February 1, 2020





Today – A mix of sun and clouds is anticipated this morning, with skies becoming mostly cloudy or overcast this afternoon. An isolated shower will become possible by late morning, with showers becoming scattered for the afternoon. There is a 10-20% lightning probability during the afternoon hours. Northnorthwesterly winds are forecast to increase through the day, with wind gusts of 20-25 mph anticipated this afternoon. The temperature will reach a high in the upper 80s.

Rainfall through 7pm: 0.10" – 0.25", locally higher possible in thunderstorms.

Tomorrow – A few rounds of showers may drift down from the terrain north-northeast of the golf course, with the highest precipitation chances expected from the late morning through the early afternoon hours. The majority of this activity is expected to be of a lighter intensity, though a brief heavier shower cannot be ruled out. Gusty north-northeasterly winds could reach peak speeds to 28 mph during the afternoon. The temperature will reach a high in the upper 80s.
