Today – Pop-up showers will become possible this afternoon, with the highest chances expected from 2-4pm. Any showers that occur may produce moderate to briefly heavy rainfall intensities. Erratic winds are forecast for this afternoon, with variable wind directions anticipated. A northerly wind gust to 15-20 mph may become possible this afternoon, but any such gust would be quite infrequent. **Sunrise: 6:39am / Sunset: 6:23pm Rainfall: 0.10" or less.**

Extended forecast – Northerly winds will attempt to become more established on Friday and Saturday afternoon, but the strongest and most consistent wind gusts are predicted to arrive on Sunday. Scattered showers are expected Friday afternoon as moisture values rise ahead of a disturbance set to move through on Saturday. Showers will become likely on Saturday afternoon as a disturbance drifts westward through Panama. An isolated thunderstorm is additionally possible Saturday afternoon. Showers chances will continue on Sunday, but the coverage and intensity of this activity is expected to be reduced as drier air builds in and northerly winds increase.
