











Extended Forecast – A weak front will move through Friday morning with nothing more than a period of elevated winds. Otherwise, mostly sunny skies and mild conditions can be expected. The main concern this weekend will be the potential for Tropical development in the Gulf of Mexico. If something organized can form this weekend, there would be an increased risk for moisture pushing back into the Savannah area, especially by Sunday. Due to this, rain chances have been increased for Sunday and may have to be increased even farther in future updates.
