**Extended Forecast** – A cold front will push through the Nassau area tonight and then eventually stall out over the Central Bahamas on Tuesday. Showers and perhaps and isolated T-storm will be possible, especially this evening. Most of the day Tuesday appears dry at this point. An area of low pressure will then develop along the old front Tuesday night which could bring another period of showers to Nassau. This low then pulls away on Wednesday with the shower threat diminishing. Winds will begin to increases out of the north on Tuesday and more so on Wednesday. Gusts over 25 mph are possible.
