












The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic 6am Weather Forecast Sunday January 19, 2020

Extended Forecast – Dry and cool conditions are expected to tonight with temperatures falling into the lower 60s. Most of Monday should remain dry, however a cold front will be arriving late in the day. Showers are possible but it looks like the better chances will hold off until Monday night. A T-storm also can't be ruled out but the threat is low. An area of low pressure will develop just east of the Bahamas on Tuesday with the threat for showers continuing into Tuesday and possibly Wednesday. The heaviest precipitation is expected to remain to the north and east.
