Extended Forecast – A weaker area of high pressure will maintain itself over the western Atlantic through Thursday with easterly flow remaining in place. Wind speeds will continue to diminish with gusts likely remaining under 25 mph both Tuesday and Wednesday. Given the pattern in place, a passing rain showers could occur at any time, however the threat is very low. A weak cold front is expected to arrive late Friday with a better chance for showers in the Nassau area.
