Today – Mostly dry conditions are expected today, however with easterly flow in place a passing shower can't be ruled. Any shower would only last 5-10 minutes but could produce a brief heavy downpour. Easterly winds will be sustained a 18-24 mph with gusts to around 30 mph. Wind speeds on the front 9 will be more inconsistent and likely 5-10 mph lower than the back 9. Rainfall: Less than 0.05". **Sunrise: 6:48am / Sunset: 5:36pm**

Extended Forecast – High pressure over the western Atlantic will continue to weaken and this will cause winds speeds to gradually diminish. Gusts should fall below 25 mph by Tuesday and 20 mph by Wednesday. A risk for a brief shower will persist through mid-week but chances are only in the 10-20% range each day.
