Extended Forecast – An uptick in shower activity is expected tonight with some these possibly affecting Exuma. Most of these showers are expected to dissipate Wednesday morning with dry conditions likely the rest of the day. Easterly winds of 12-18 mph, gusting 20-25 mph will continue through the Final Round. Relatively dry conditions are expected in Nassau on Thursday with a weak frontal boundary arriving late Friday. Showers could develop as early as Friday afternoon and then continue into Saturday morning. Lightning is not expected. Gusty northeast winds will occur behind the front.
