Saturday – A few isolated thunderstorms are possible later this afternoon. These storms are expected to develop slightly west of King & Bear after 2pm along the Atlantic sea breeze, then steering winds are then expected to cause these storms to slowly drift east after 3pm. Slow-moving showers and thunderstorms may lead to locally heavy rainfall, however the highest threat of thunderstorms and heavy rainfall is closer to the Florida-Georgia border.
