






Extended forecast – A gradual increase in moisture over the next couple days will return the threat for afternoon showers and potentially a few thunderstorms. The highest risk for precipitation and thunderstorms will arrive on Friday – mainly during the mid-afternoon through early evening hours as the Atlantic sea breeze moves inland. Slow-moving showers and thunderstorms on Friday may lead to localized moderate to heavy rainfall. Afternoon showers and isolated storms will remain possible this weekend, with temperatures reaching highs in the lower 90s.
