





## 7am Weather Forecast

**Today** – Showers and thunderstorms will begin to develop across the mountains around 12pm, sending outflow boundaries eastward into the plains. The boundaries should generate a scattered coverage of thunderstorms during the early to mid-afternoon hours. The majority of the thunderstorm activity should be east of TPC Colorado by the early evening, but outflow boundaries drifting back towards the course could allow for a few more showers or storms before largely turning dry after sunset.

**Tomorrow** – Showers and thunderstorms will begin developing in the mountains during the late morning hours on Saturday, once again sending outflow boundaries towards TPC Colorado during the early afternoon hours. Slow-moving scattered thunderstorms are expected during the afternoon and into the evening, with locally heavy rainfall possible. The highest precipitation chances will arrive after 2-3pm and roughly last through 5-6pm. Winds will start out north-northeasterly before turning easterly by midday. Afternoon winds will be highly erratic and gusty due to these scattered thunderstorms and their associated outflows.
