







# TPC Colorado Championship

## 6am Weather Forecast







**Today** – Showers and thunderstorms are expected to develop over the mountains late this morning – sending outflow boundaries eastward into the plains. The boundaries should generate a scattered coverage of thunderstorms during the early to mid-afternoon hours. The majority of the thunderstorm activity should be east of TPC Colorado by the early evening, with just an isolated shower risk after sunset. The temperature will top out near 90F. North-northeasterly winds will turn east-northeasterly by midday before becoming more erratic and gusty due to nearby showers and storms.

**Rainfall: 0.10" – 0.25" with locally higher totals in slow-moving thunderstorms.**

**Tomorrow** – Expect another day with dry conditions in the morning followed by the potential for outflow boundaries from showers and storms in the mountains to kick off activity near TPC Colorado. By the early evening the majority of the shower and thunderstorm activity should be east of the course.
