Today – Dry conditions are expected under sunny skies. Some clouds may build up in the mountains, with any weak afternoon or evening showers remaining southwest of TPC Colorado in the higher terrain. Forecast winds have trended higher, with southeasterly winds expected to become breezy in the afternoon, with gusts in the 17-22 mph range. The temperature should top out around 87F.

Extended forecast – Afternoon thunderstorms are expected to remain fairly isolated on Thursday as a high pressure ridge works to suppress storm development. Better chances for thunderstorms over northeastern Colorado may send gusty outflow boundaries back towards TPC Colorado later Thursday afternoon. Moisture will build under the ridge for Friday and Saturday, allowing for afternoon storm coverage to ratchet up each day. Slow storm motion may lead to locally heavy rainfall each afternoon and evening. Winds will become more erratic and gusty at times in the vicinity of these afternoon thunderstorms.
