





## 7am Weather Forecast

**Tomorrow** – Some rain shower activity is possible Sunday morning with breezy southeast winds gusting 20-30 mph. Lightning can't be ruled out but the threat appears low. Winds could briefly become southwesterly early in the afternoon. If this happens, gusts of 30-40 mph would be possible. The cold front is expected to move through between 3-6pm. Winds will abruptly shift to the north with gusts over 30 mph possible and a sharp decrease in temperature. Rain and thunderstorm chances will be on the increase, especially behind the front. Steadier rain will become more likely after 6pm.
