**Today** – A strong cold front will push through northern Utah this afternoon, most likely between 3-5pm. Showers/storms will be possible, mainly after 3pm. Lightning risk should diminish quickly after 6pm with steady rain this evening. Southerly wind gusts of 20-30 mph are expected to develop early this afternoon. Winds will abruptly shift to the north and remain gusty through the early evening. Wind gusts could exceed 40 mph directly ahead and behind the front. **Sunrise: 5:58am / Sunset: 9:03pm**
