Today – A weak front will push through northern Utah during the day with a slight chance for shower/T-storm development in the area. Any precipitation, if it develops, would be brief. A period of gusty northerly winds may accompany the front, most likely between 12-6pm. Gusts during this time frame could exceed 20 mph. Cooler temperatures will be in place today, likely only reaching the middle 80s.

Extended Forecast – Dry conditions are likely on Friday, however an isolated shower/T-storm could develop in the mountains during the afternoon. Mostly sunny skies and warmer conditions expected on Saturday with temperatures climbing into the 90s. A strong front approaches the area Sunday into Monday. Any precipitation with this front should hold off until late Sunday or Monday. The bigger concern is the potential for gusty southerly winds. Wind gusts of 20-30 mph are possible, however confidence in the magnitude of the wind remains low.
