Extended forecast – Windy and dry on Saturday, with south-southwesterly gusts of 22-27 mph arriving after 9-10am. The strongest/most frequent gusts are expected Saturday afternoon. Showers and perhaps an isolated embedded thunderstorm will become possible after 2pm Sunday afternoon as a cold front moves into the area. Winds will shift from the southeast to the northeast behind this front between 3-4pm. Precipitation chances will increase Sunday evening/Sunday night as an upper-level trough drops into the Central Plains behind the surface cold front. High temperatures will warm into the low 90s on Saturday before cooling back into the low 80s for Sunday.
