Today – A weak cold front is moving onshore this morning with areas of showers moving into the northern Willamette Valley. These showers will remain light in intensity with most precipitation occurring before 10am. A low shower threat may linger into the early afternoon, otherwise skies will become partly cloudy. Temperatures will be much cooler today, likely only reaching the lower 70s. **Rainfall today: ~0.05". Sunrise: 6:01am / Sunset: 8:33pm**

Extended Forecast – Lingering low-level moisture and light winds could allow some fog development late tonight into Friday morning. Otherwise, morning clouds/fog will give way to afternoon sun and comfortable temperatures. A weak front will pass to our north Friday night into Saturday with a marine layer surge expected. The marine layer could be deep enough to produce some drizzle Saturday morning. Behind this front, offshore gradients will strengthen with warming temperatures, especially by Sunday. Light winds during the morning will give way to north to northwest winds during the afternoon.
