Things to Know

- Michael Thompson and Richy Werenski tie the tournament record for low 54-hole total (198)
- With a victory, Thompson or Werenski will earn a spot into next week’s 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational
- Tony Finau trails by two and seeks second TOUR victory; has instructor Boyd Summerhays on the bag
- The top two players (not otherwise exempt) in the top 10 and ties will be invited to the 2020 U.S. Open

- 1 Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win the 3M Open (Matthew Wolff)
- 198 54-hole scoring record at the 3M Open (Thompson, Werenski/2020 and Bryson DeChambeau, Wolff, Collin Morikawa/2019)

Michael Thompson (T1/-15)

- Marks his third 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2011 The RSM Classic/3rd, 2013 The Honda Classic/Won)
- Has made just two bogeys through the first three rounds, best of any player in the field
- With a victory, will earn a spot into the 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational and the 2020 U.S. Open
- Entered the week No. 151 in the FedExCup and is projected to move inside the top 50 with a win
- Seeking second career PGA TOUR victory (2013 The Honda Classic) in his 228th career start

Richy Werenski (T1/-15)

- Marks his first 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR
- In search of his second top-10 of the season (T3/A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier)
- Has held at least a share of the lead after each round this week
- Seeks first TOUR win in 99th start; two runner ups (P2/2017 Barracuda Championship, T2/2018 Barbasol Championship)

- With a victory, will earn a spot into the 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational and the 2020 U.S. Open

Miscellaneous notes

- Chasing his second TOUR victory, **Tony Finau** (T3/-13) has the most top-eight finishes (24) of any player without a win on TOUR in the last four seasons
- **Charl Schwartzel** (T3/-13) is the only player to make birdie or better on every par-5 hole this week, the first time in his TOUR career to do so
- **Cameron Tringale** (T6/-11) tied his career-low with an 8-under 63 (R2/2011 THE NORTHERN TRUST) after carding a back-nine score of 6-under 30
- Following missed cuts in four of his last five starts, **Max Homa** (5th/-12) posted a 7-under 64 for his third round of 64 or better this season (63/R3/The American Express, 64/R3/Waste Management Phoenix Open)
- Defending champion **Matthew Wolff** (T13/-10) is hoping to become the first player to win his first two PGA TOUR titles at the same event since Daniel Berger won back-to-back in Memphis (2016, 2017)
- The top two players (not otherwise exempt) in the top 10 and ties will be invited to the 2020 U.S. Open; In the event of a tie, the higher-ranked player entering the week in the OWGR will earn the spot
