Today – There is an isolated risk for a passing shower or thunderstorm this morning as a warm front lifts through the area. Dry, hot, humid, and breezy conditions are then anticipated this afternoon under partly cloudy skies, with southerly wind gusts of 20-25 mph forecast. The heat index will reach 100F.

Extended forecast – A complex of showers and thunderstorms will move from the Dakotas into western Minnesota by early Saturday. This activity may reach TPC Twin Cities in a weakened form after 8am Saturday. Once cloud cover from the morning activity dissipates, expect showers and thunderstorms to redevelop Saturday afternoon, with the highest coverage expected after 3-4pm. A cold front is expected to bring another round of showers and thunderstorms overnight Saturday into Sunday morning, with heavy rainfall expected. The boundary will move south of the area Sunday morning, with precipitation chances diminishing around 7am. A few passing showers or thunderstorms may develop Sunday afternoon, but any interruption would likely be brief. Heat indices will be in the upper 90s to near 100F on Saturday and could reach the low 90s Sunday.
