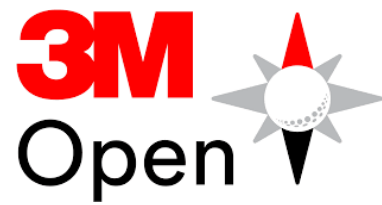

Today – A complex of showers and thunderstorms currently over western/central Minnesota is expected to weaken as it approaches TPC Twin Cities this morning. The remnants of this complex will likely arrive as a band of moderate rain between 9-11am, with a 20% risk for embedded lightning and pockets of heavier rainfall rates. A lull in activity is expected for a few hours from the late morning into the early afternoon as cloud cover from this morning's activity erodes. Scattered showers and thunderstorms are then expected to develop after 2-3pm, with chances becoming likely this evening and overnight.

Extended forecast – A cold front is expected to bring another round of showers and thunderstorms overnight Saturday into Sunday morning, with heavy rainfall possible. The boundary will move south of the area Sunday morning, with precipitation chances beginning to diminish around daybreak. An upper-level feature may bring a few passing showers or thunderstorms Sunday afternoon, but any interruption is expected to be relatively brief. The temperature will reach a high in the mid-80s.
