Today – Should any patches of fog develop they are likely to lift by 8am. A 20% risk for a pop-up shower or thunderstorm will exist between 1-4pm ahead of a cold front moving into northern Florida. After 4pm the shower and thunderstorm chances are forecast to gradually increase as the front slowly drifts southeastward into central Florida – with the highest chances arriving overnight. Southwesterly winds will gust between 25-30 mph after 2pm. The temperature is forecast to reach a high in the upper 80s.

Extended forecast – A scattered coverage of showers and thunderstorms are expected this evening and overnight as a cold front works through the region. The highest rainfall chances are forecast to occur between 10pm-1am as the boundary passes overhead. Rainfall totals will hold below 0.25". Dry, cooler, and breezy conditions are then forecast for Friday through the weekend behind the front.
