Things to Know

- Nick Taylor begins his round with an eagle en route to an 8-under 63 and second 18-hole lead on the PGA TOUR
- Patrick Cantlay ties career-high with nine birdies, good for a 66, in bid for third career PGA TOUR title
- PGA TOUR rookie Chase Seiffert ties career-low round in relation to par with 6-under 66 at Pebble Beach
- Phil Mickelson birdies last three holes to open with 4-under 68 at Spyglass Hill in title defense
- Jason Day opens with 4-under 67; seeks fourth straight top-five finish at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- 2018 team champions Kevin Streelman and Larry Fitzgerald lead the team portion of the competition

- 5 First-round leaders/co-leaders of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am since 2000 to convert for the win (most recent: D.A. Points/2011)
- 1 First-round leader/co-leader to win on TOUR in 2019-20 (Tiger Woods/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP)

Nick Taylor (1st/MP/63/-8)

- Takes an 18-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR for a second time (2019 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open/T29)
- Becomes the first player with multiple outright 18-hole leads on the PGA TOUR in 2019-20
- Began his round with an eagle-three at No. 10 at Monterey Peninsula Country Club
- Birdied his last two holes to post a bogey-free 8-under 63 and tie his career-low round (four times; most recently in round one of the 2019 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- The 63 marks the lowest opening-round score in the event since Chez Reavie opened with an 8-under 63 at Monterey Peninsula in 2016 (T26)
- In five previous starts at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, lone top-10 finish, a T10, came in 2017

- Making his 10th start of the 2019-20 PGA TOUR Season, with a T10 at the Safeway Open his lone top-10 showing
- Winner of the 2014 Sanderson Farms Championship
- After winning the Canadian Junior Championship by a record 11 strokes in 2006, won the 2009 Mark H. McCormack Medal after holding the R&A's World Amateur Golf Ranking for 21 straight weeks

Patrick Cantlay (T2/SH/66/-6)

- Made nine birdies in round one to start his fourth AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, tying his career-high for birdies in a round
- Marks the third occasion (of four) to open with a 66 at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and lowest score at Spyglass (previously a 70 in round two of 2013)
- Lone top-10 finish in three previous tournament starts was a T9 (2013)
- In three previous starts on the PGA TOUR this season, lost in a playoff at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, finished fourth at the Sentry Tournament of Champions and T40 at the Safeway Open.
- Competed for the victorious American team in December in the Presidents Cup
- Winner of 2018 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, 2019 the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide

Chase Seiffert (T2/PB/66/-6)

- Making his first start in the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, PGA TOUR rookie made four birdies, the only eagle of the day at the par-five 18th and no bogeys en route to tying his career-low score (relation to par)
- Earned his way to the PGA TOUR by virtue of a 26th-place finish on the 2019 priority rank on the Korn Ferry Tour, where he amassed five top-10 finishes
- In 10 starts so far this season, a T21 at The American Express marks his best result (No. 123 in FedExCup)

Phil Mickelson (T12/SH/68/-4)

- Defending champion finished with three straight birdies on Nos. 16-18 at Spyglass Hill en route to a 4-under 68
- Hit 10 of 14 fairways and 15 of 18 greens in regulation; came into the week ranked 112th in Strokes Gained: Off The Tee and 91st in Strokes Gained: Approach The Green
- Five-time AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am champion (1998, 2005, 2007, 2012, 2019) looks to surpass Mark O'Meara for most wins in the event; last repeat winner was Dustin Johnson (2009, 2010)
- Is in search of his 15th win in the state of California since 1983; currently tied for most with Tiger Woods
- Comes off back-to-back missed cuts in his last two TOUR starts (The American Express, Farmers Insurance Open)
- Is making his 24th start in the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and 620th start on TOUR this week

Additional Player Notes

- Making his first start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, **Harold Varner (T4/PB)** opened with a 5-under 67 at Pebble Beach; seeks first PGA TOUR victory in his 125th start. As a junior golfer and member of the First Tee, won the PURE Insurance Championship with PGA TOUR Champions player Morris Hatalsky
- Making his 11th start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, **Jason Day (T12/MP)** opened with 4-under 67 at Monterey Peninsula Country Club in his bid for a fourth consecutive top-five finish in the event (2019/T4, 2018/T2, 2017/T5)
- 2009, 2010 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am champion **Dustin Johnson (T24/SH)** opened with a 3-under 69 at Spyglass Hill in his 13th consecutive start in the event. Including two victories, has eight top-10 finishes in 12 previous starts
- AT&T-sponsored athlete/2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am champion **Jordan Spieth (T44/SH)** opened with a 2-under 70 in his eighth start at the event
