Things to Know

- Nick Taylor wins the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am by four strokes to earn his second PGA TOUR victory and first since 2014
- Taylor is the first wire-to-wire victor at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am since Phil Mickelson in 2005
- Taylor is the tournament's first international winner since Vijay Singh (Fiji) won in 2004
- Taylor becomes the sixth Canadian with multiple official PGA TOUR wins
- Phil Mickelson becomes the third player in PGA TOUR history with at least one top-10 in 30 consecutive seasons
- Kevin Streelman and Larry Fitzgerald became the fourth team to win multiple titles in the Pro-Am competition

PGA TOUR titles (2): 2014 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2020 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am

- First wire-to-wire victor on TOUR since Nate Lashley (2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- First wire-to-wire victor of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am since Phil Mickelson in 2005
- First international winner of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am since Vijay Singh in 2004
- One of three players to tee off No. 1 Sunday and card an under-par round (Taylor/70, Kevin Streelman/68, Daniel Berger/69)
- Fourth straight tournament winner to win by at least three shots
- 19-under total is his best career 72-hole score in relation to par (previous best: 18-under 270, T15/2019 Barbasol Championship)
- Holed out from off the green twice on Sunday:
 - 47-foot, 3-inch bunker shot for eagle on the par-5 6th
 - 35-foot, 8-inch chip from the rough for birdie on the par-4 15th

- Becomes the sixth Canadian with multiple wins on the PGA TOUR (15 Canadians have 36 official victories on TOUR)
 - 8 wins – Mike Weir, George Knudson
 - 4 – Stephen Ames
 - 3 – Stan Leonard
 - 2 – Nick Taylor, Dave Barr
 - 1 – Corey Conners, Ian Leggatt, Richard Zokol, Dan Halldorson, Al Balding, Jules Huot, Al Johnston, Mackenzie Hughes, Adam Hadwin
- Extended his streak to 226 holes without a 3-putt
- The last six winners of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am have finished the week among the top-10 in Greens in Regulation; Taylor hit 54 of 72 and was T3 in the field

Kevin Streelman (2nd/-15); SH-MP-PB-PB

- Of the 34 players that teed off on No. 1 Sunday, only three players carded under-par rounds: Streelman (68/2nd), Daniel Berger (69/T5) and Nick Taylor (70/1st)
- He was the only player to card four rounds in the 60s this week
- The runner-up finish is his third straight top-10 at this event (T7/2019, 6th/2018)
- It is his best finish since being runner-up at the 2014 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open
- In his last five starts, he had four missed cuts and a T45 at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Streelman and Larry Fitzgerald won the Pro-Am portion of the competition by five shots with a 33-under total. It was their second win as a team (2018) and they are the fourth tandem with multiple victories.

Phil Mickelson (3rd/-14); SH-MP-PB-PB

- Becomes the third player in PGA TOUR history with at least one top-10 in 30 consecutive seasons, joining Sam Snead and Raymond Floyd

- Records his 10th top-three finish at this event (five wins, two seconds, three thirds)
- Played his last 12 holes in 5-over
- Posts his first top-10 on TOUR since his win at this event last year

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Jason Day** (4th/-11) posted his fourth straight top-five finish at this event (4th/2020, T4/2019, T2/2018, T5/2017) and first top-five on TOUR since a T5 at the 2019 Masters Tournament
- **Jordan Spieth**, winner of the 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, carded the day's best score (5-under 67) and improved from T55 to T9. He carded just three final-round scores in the 60s in 2018-19 (best: 67, THE NORTHERN TRUST), and this was his first final-round score in the 60s this season
- **Maverick McNealy** carded weekend rounds of 66-68 (MP-PB) to finish T5 after being T89 through two rounds; his 4-under 68 was Sunday's only bogey-free round
- With a T5, **Charl Schwartzel** earned 96 FedExCup points towards his Major Medical Extension; now has 10 starts remaining to earn at least 166 FedExCup points to equal No. 125 on the 2018-19 FedExCup points list (Pat Perez/376)
