



FedExCup Notes

Top 70 Breakdown (69 players in field): Three players (Phil Mickelson, 13 / Dustin Johnson, 12th / Bubba Watson, 12th) have qualified for the BMW Championship in at least 12 seasons of the FedExCup. Since 2007, 12 players have qualified for the BMW Championship in 11 or more seasons (including this season).

7 First Timers & Rookies: Seven players remaining in the top 70 are making their first career FedExCup Playoffs appearance this season. PGA TOUR rookie **Scottie Scheffler (14th)** currently ranks 14th in the FedExCup standings, is the highest ranked Rookie entering the BMW Championship. Scottie Scheffler and Viktor Hovland are seeking to become the next Rookie's to qualify for the TOUR Championship in the FedExCup era.

4 FedExCup Champions: Four FedExCup champions are currently inside the top 70 of the FedExCup standings (Rory McIlroy, Justin Thomas, Billy Horschel & Tiger Woods).

Webb Simpson entered the FedExCup Playoffs ninth in the standings last season and finished 16th in the final standings. Simpson was the highest ranked player in the standings without a victory entering the FedExCup Playoffs.

2013 FedExCup champion **Henrik Stenson** was the highest ranked player in the standings without a victory entering the Playoffs (9th).

Entering the 2020 BMW Championship, there are currently 11 players ranked inside the top 30 of the FedExCup standings without a win this season.

Harris English (6th) is the highest ranked player without a win this season and is coming off his best finish on the PGA TOUR since 2016 (2nd at THE NORTHERN TRUST).

Dustin Johnson (1st), Justin Thomas (2nd)

FedExCup leader **Dustin Johnson** enters the BMW Championship ranked first in the standings for the 40th time of his career (fourth-most all-time). Defending BMW Championship winner **Justin Thomas (2nd)** has recorded 19 rounds par or better at this event in 20 career rounds.

- 5** Tied with Rory McIlroy for the most wins in the FedExCup Playoffs (5)
- 149** Second most total eagles made on the PGA TOUR of any player since 2007 (149). Dustin Johnson tied the PGA TOUR record for most eagles made in a four-round event with five eagles last week en route to victory at THE NORTHERN TRUST.

Daniel Berger (4th), Collin Morikawa (5th), Harris English (6th)

Daniel Berger (4th) is one of four players with 12 or more rounds without a round over par at the BMW Championship during the FedExCup Playoffs. **Collin Morikawa (5th)** is coming off just his third missed cut of his PGA TOUR career. **Harris English (6th)** has made 184 starts on the PGA TOUR since his last win (2013 Mayakoba Golf Classic), second most starts of any player without a win in this time frame (S. Brown/192).

- 3** One of three players who are currently inside the top 30 of the FedExCup who didn't qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs last season (Harris English & Brendon Todd)
- 1st** Leads TOUR in Scrambling (68.13%)

Six-time PGA TOUR winner Bryson DeChambeau (7th) is one of four players with 12 or more career rounds without a round over par at the BMW Championship during the FedExCup Playoffs. **Sungjae Im (8th)** is one of eight First-Time Winners on TOUR this season. **Jon Rahm (9th)** has ranked inside the top 10 of the FedExCup in 71 weeks since the start of the 2016-17 PGA TOUR season, third-most of any player (Justin Thomas/123 & Dustin Johnson/94).

Patrick Reed (10th), Xander Schauffele (11th), Rory McIlroy (12th)

Patrick Reed (10th) is one of three players with an active streak of six or more consecutive seasons qualifying for the TOUR Championship (Hideki Matsuyama/6 & Dustin Johnson/11). **Xander Schauffele (11th)** is seeking his fourth consecutive trip to East Lake GC where he captured the 2017 TOUR Championship. Two-time FedExCup champion **Rory McIlroy (12th)** is seeking to join Justin Rose (2018), Justin Thomas (2017), Jordan Spieth (2015) and Brandt Snedeker (2012) as the only reigning FedExCup champions to qualify for the TOUR Championship in the season following their respective FedExCup title.

Fast Facts on Patrick Reed:

- 3** One of three players with an active streak of six or more consecutive seasons qualifying for the TOUR Championship (Hideki Matsuyama/6 & Dustin Johnson/11)
- 27.77** leads all players in the FedExCup Playoffs with the lowest putts per round average of any player (min 50 rds). In his 105 career rounds in the Playoffs, Reed is averaging 27.77 putts per round.
- 7.90** Patrick Reed has the fifth highest one-putts per round average in the FedExCup Playoffs of players with 50 or more rounds played. In his career, Reed averages 7.90 one-putts per round during the FedExCup Playoffs.
- 98.23%** ranks second in Putting from inside five feet of all players with 50 or more rounds in the FedExCup Playoffs. Reed has made 1,388 of 1,413 putts from inside five feet (98.23%).
- 15** One of four players with a current streak of 15 or more consecutive rounds of par or better on TOUR (Svensson/19, Perez/15, Schauffele/15)

Fast Facts on Xander Schauffele:
