Today – Partly cloudy becoming a mix of sun and clouds for the afternoon hours. Largely expecting a lull in shower and thunderstorm activity prior to the arrival of a broken line of strong thunderstorms forecast to reach Olympia Fields around 9pm this evening – but cannot rule out an isolated thunderstorm or two this afternoon due to hot and humid conditions in place and an active radar to our north across southern Wisconsin. Southwesterly wind gusts up to 18 mph are expected this afternoon. The temperature will reach a high in the low 90s, while the heat index is forecast to top out around 100F.

Extended forecast – A broken line of strong thunderstorms is forecast to arrive around 9pm tonight, with the greatest precipitation chances expected through midnight before becoming scattered into early Saturday. Total rainfall of 0.30" – 0.70" is anticipated. Rain and storm chances will come to an end by 4am Saturday, with cooler and dry conditions for the weekend.
