Harold Varner III (1st/-11)

- Second-round 66 is the lowest score in the ShotLink era by a player who started his round with a triple bogey or worse (691 such rounds from 2003-present)
- Opening 36-hole score of 129 (63-66) is his career-low on the PGA TOUR (previous: 130/2018 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier)
- First career 36-hole lead/co-lead and first solo lead after any round

Jordan Spieth (T2/-10)

In search of first PGA TOUR victory since The 2017 Open Championship

- Third career opening 36-hole score of 130; won the previous two events (2015 Masters Tournament, 2016 Sentry Tournament of Champions)
- Winner of 2016 Charles Schwab Challenge and has four additional top-10s at the event
- 4-putt at No. 3: ninth 4-putt of his PGA TOUR career; first 4-putt since 2019 World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational (No. 12/R1); first 4-putt of his career at Colonial Country Club (534th hole)

Additional Player Notes

- At T3, **Collin Morikawa** made his 21st straight cut to start his professional career on the PGA TOUR, the second-longest streak to start a career in the last 30 years (longest: Tiger Woods/25)
- World No. 1 and 2019 FedExCup champion **Rory McIlroy**, who entered the week on a streak of seven consecutive top-five finishes on TOUR, is T4 in his tournament debut
- Among the notable players missing the cut: Jason Day, Rickie Fowler, Sergio Garcia, Dustin Johnson, Phil Mickelson, Jon Rahm
