#### Things to Know

- Daniel Berger defeats Collin Morikawa in a playoff to earn his third PGA TOUR title
- Berger moves to No. 11 in the FedExCup standings
- All three of Berger's victories on TOUR have come during the second week of June
- Berger has played 28 consecutive rounds of par or better, the longest active streak on TOUR
- Collin Morikawa missed putts inside six feet at the 72nd hole (5'9") and playoff hole (3'0")
- Updated playoff records – Berger: 1-2; Morikawa: 0-1

- Defeats Collin Morikawa with a par at the first playoff hole (par-4 17<sup>th</sup>) to earn his third PGA TOUR victory
- All three of his PGA TOUR wins to date have come during the second week of June (2016 FedEx St. Jude Classic, 2017 FedEx St. Jude Classic, 2020 Charles Schwab Challenge)
- Moves to No. 11 in the FedExCup standings, his highest position since the start of the 2017-18 season; missed the FedExCup Playoffs for the first time in his career in 2018-19
- Final-round 66 represents his 28th consecutive par-or-better score, the longest active streak on the PGA TOUR
- 265 marks career-low 72-hole score (previous: 267 twice, most recent 2016 FedEx St. Jude Classic)
- Finished in the top-10 in three consecutive starts leading into the suspension of the season (T9/Waste Management Phoenix Open, T5/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, T4/The Honda Classic)

#### Collin Morikawa (P2/-15)

- Missed putts inside six feet at the 72nd hole (5'9") and playoff hole (3'0")

- Second career runner-up finish in 23<sup>rd</sup> TOUR start (T2/2019 3M Open, P2/2020 Charles Schwab Challenge)
- First playoff appearance on TOUR
- Has never missed a cut in 21 professional starts, the second-longest streak in the last 30 years (Tiger Woods began his career with 25 consecutive cuts made)

#### Additional Player Notes

- **Xander Schauffele** (T3) falls to 0-for-3 with the 54-hole lead/co-lead in PGA TOUR career (2018 The Open Championship, 2020 Sentry Tournament of Champions, 2020 Charles Schwab Challenge)
- With a T32, **Rory McIlroy** snapped his streak of seven consecutive top-fives on the PGA TOUR; last finish of T6 or worse came at the 2019 BMW Championship
