#### Things to Know

- An eight-time winner at Torrey Pines (seven Farmers Insurance Open titles, one U.S. Open title/2008), Tiger Woods seeks record-breaking 83<sup>rd</sup> career PGA TOUR victory
- Justin Rose won the 2019 Farmers Insurance Open for his 10<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR title, becoming the winningest player from England since 1945; seeks to become the first back-to-back winner of the event since Tiger Woods (2005-08)
- Six FedExCup champions in the field: Tiger Woods (2007, 2009), Brandt Snedeker (2012), Billy Horschel (2014), Jordan Spieth (2015), Rory McIlroy (2016, 2019), Justin Rose (2018)
- 11 of the last 13 Farmers Insurance Open champions have qualified for the FedExCup finale, the TOUR Championship

#### FedExCup and the Farmers Insurance Open

- The 2019-20 PGA TOUR Season marks the 14<sup>th</sup> season of the FedExCup and includes the second edition of the Wyndham Rewards Top 10, where the top 10 players in the FedExCup at the conclusion of the Regular Season earn a share of \$10 million
- 11 of the 13 Farmers Insurance Open champions have qualified for the FedExCup finale, the TOUR Championship (Scott Stallings/2014 and Tiger Woods/2008); after winning the event in 2008, Tiger Woods was unable to compete in the FedExCup Playoffs due to injury
- Woods (2007) and Brandt Snedeker (2012) are the only two players to win the Farmers Insurance Open and the FedExCup in the same season
- Seven FedExCup champions in the field: Tiger Woods (2007, 2009), Bill Haas (2011), Brandt Snedeker (2012), Billy Horschel (2014), Jordan Spieth (2015), Rory McIlroy (2016, 2019), Justin Rose (2018)

The top 10 in the FedExCup at the conclusion of the PGA TOUR Regular Season will be recognized through the Wyndham Rewards Top 10 program and be well-positioned entering the FedExCup Playoffs.

# Justin Rose set to defend 2019 Farmers Insurance Open victory

- Won 2019 Farmers Insurance Open for 10<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR title, becoming the winningest player from England since 1945
- Seeking to join three players who have won back-to-back at the Farmers Insurance Open: J.C. Snead (1975-76), Phil Mickelson (2000-01), Tiger Woods (2005-08)
- Became first player since Ben Crane (2010) to win after playing North Course in opening round
- Became first player since Tiger Woods (2013) to convert 54-hole lead/co-lead at Farmers Insurance Open
- Will make 11<sup>th</sup> Farmers Insurance Open start, with three consecutive top-10 finishes (T4/2017, T8/2018, 1<sup>st</sup>/2019)
- Finished T28 at the 2019 WGC-HSBC Champions in his only other TOUR start this season
- Won the 2017-18 FedExCup by a margin of 41 points over Tiger Woods

# **Tiger Woods at Torrey Pines**

- Won the 2019 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP for his 82<sup>nd</sup> PGA TOUR victory, tying Sam Snead for the most ever on TOUR
- Has won the Farmers Insurance Open seven times (1999, 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2013); only Woods and Phil Mickelson have more than two wins in the event
- Won the 2008 U.S. Open at Torrey Pines, when he defeated Rocco Mediate in a playoff to win
- Only two players have won a single event eight times on TOUR: Sam Snead (Wyndham Championship/8 wins); Tiger Woods (WGC/FedEx St. Jude Invitational/8 wins, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard/8 wins)
- Has won four events seven or more times: 8 wins WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational, Arnold Palmer Invitational; 7 wins Farmers Insurance Open, WGC-Mexico Championship
- With win at the 2013 Farmers Insurance Open, became the first player in TOUR history to win on the same golf course eight times, including his U.S. Open victory

# Additional player notes

- 2015 and 2018 Farmers Insurance Open champion Jason Day won in 2018 in a six-hole playoff over Alex Noren
  (Ryan Palmer was eliminated from the playoff after the first hole); the six-hole playoff was the longest in the
  tournament's 67-year history and was just the third in the last 50 years of being played at Torrey Pines to last
  three holes or more
- **Tony Finau** has finished inside the top-25 in all five of his starts at the Farmers Insurance Open (T24/2015, T18/2016, T4/2017, T6/2018, T13/2019)
- Rickie Fowler's best finish in 10 prior starts at the Farmers Insurance Open was T5 in his inaugural start in 2010
- Reigning FedExCup champion Rory McIlroy finished T5 last year in his first start at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Jon Rahm won his first (of three) career PGA TOUR title at the 2017 Farmers Insurance Open
- A T19 in 2014 marks **Jordan Spieth**'s best finish in four previous starts at the Farmers Insurance Open; made his professional debut on TOUR at the 2013 Farmers insurance Open
