Things to Know

- On Australia Day, Marc Leishman overcomes a four-stroke deficit with 65, his lowest score in 44 rounds at the Farmers Insurance Open; claims fifth career PGA TOUR title
- Leishman becomes the third player since 2010 to win after playing round one on the North Course
- In bid to become 10th multiple winner of the Farmers Insurance Open, 54-hole leader Jon Rahm finishes solo-second
- In two starts at the Farmers Insurance Open, Rory McIlroy has finished T3 (2020) and T5 (2019)
- Tiger Woods finishes T9 in his first attempt to pass Sam Snead for most career PGA TOUR wins (83)

Marc Leishman PGA TOUR Titles (5): 2012 Travelers Championship, 2017 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, 2017 BMW Championship, 2018 CIMB Classic, **2020 Farmers Insurance Open**

- Beginning the final round four strokes off the lead, played his outgoing nine in 6-under 31 en route to a 7-under 65 and one-stroke victory at 15-under 273
- The 7-under 65 marks his lowest score in 44 rounds in the event
- Fifth career PGA TOUR win comes in his 276th PGA TOUR start at the age of 36 years, 3 months, 2 days
- Wins in his 12th start at the Farmers Insurance Open and betters two T2 finishes from 2010 and 2014
- With the win, collects 500 FedExCup points and moves from No. 49 to 7th in the standings
- Has now come from behind in the final round to win on three of five occasions, each by a minimum of three strokes
- Becomes the third player since 2010 to win after beginning the week on the North Course (Ben Crane/2010, Justin Rose/2019)

- Becomes the fourth consecutive international winner of the Farmers Insurance Open and second to hail from Australia (Justin Rose/2019, Jason Day/2018, Jon Rahm/2017)
- Win comes in his sixth start of the 2019-20 season and supplants his previous-best finish this season of 3rd (Safeway Open)
- Hit three of 14 fairways, 14 of 18 greens in regulation and took 25 putts in the final round

Jon Rahm (2nd/-14)

- Played his first five holes in 4-over par, but rallied by finishing in 5-under par on his last six holes
- Earned maiden PGA TOUR victory at the 2017 Farmers Insurance Open after making a 60' 8" eagle putt on the 72nd hole. Had a 53' 2" eagle putt on the 72nd hole this week to force sudden death. Settled for birdie, good for his fifth career runner-up finish on the PGA TOUR
- Drops to 0-2 when holding a 54-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR (2019 THE PLAYERS Championship/T12)
- Was seeking to become the 10th multiple winner of the Farmers Insurance Open
- Finished 10th at the Sentry Tournament of Champions in his only other start of the 2019-20 season

Brandt Snedeker (T3/-12)

- 2012 and 2016 Farmers Insurance Open winner was making his 14th consecutive start in the event
- Third-place finish marks his eighth top-10 finish in the Farmers Insurance Open
- Was attempting to join Tiger Woods (seven) and Phil Mickelson (three) as the only players with three or more victories at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Claims his first top-10 finish of the 2019-20 season and 77th in his 340th TOUR start
- Was seeking his 10th career PGA TOUR victory and first since the 2018 Wyndham Championship

Rory McIlroy (T3/-12)

- After three bogeys on his first four holes, played Nos. 5-9 birdie-eagle-par-birdie-birdie en route to a 3-under 69
- With a win this week, would have reclaimed the No. 1 position in the Official World Golf Rankings
- Reigning FedExCup champion finished T5 last year in his first start at the event
- Has now finished inside the top-3 in each start this season: T3/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, P1/World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions and **T3/Farmers Insurance Open**
- Was seeking his 19th career PGA TOUR win and sixth season with multiple wins

Tiger Woods (T9/-9)

- Claims his 13th top-10 finish at the Farmers Insurance Open in his 19th tournament start, dating to 1998
- With a win, would have passed Sam Snead for most career PGA TOUR victories (83)
- With a victory, would have earned ninth victory at Torrey Pines Golf Course and set the record for most wins at a single venue; (seven Farmers Insurance Open titles and one U.S. Open title/2008)
- With a victory, would have become the winningest TOUR player in California since 1983; currently tied with Phil Mickelson at 14 titles

Additional Player Notes

- Following three missed cuts in four previous starts at the Farmers Insurance Open, **Tom Hoge** (5th/-11) made six birdies against two bogeys to post a final-round 68 and claim his third top-10 finish of the season; 2nd/A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier, T6/The American Express
- **Tony Finau** (T6/-10) extends his streak of top-25 finishes to a perfect six-for-six at the Farmers Insurance Open: T24/2015, T18/2016, T4/2017, T6/2018, T13/2019)
- In his fifth start in the event, **Jordan Spieth** closes with a 2-over 74 to finish T55 at 1-uner 287
