Today – Marine layer low clouds and fog should burn-off by 8-9am. High clouds will be passing overhead at times making for partly cloudy skies. Temperatures will be mild with highs reaching the low to mid 60s. Calm wind this morning will shift out of the west 5-10 mph by midday/early afternoon.

Extended forecast – A trough of low-pressure will begin to move towards Central California on Saturday and this will begin the transition back to an on-shore flow. This will increase the marine layer along the coast, producing patchy areas of low clouds and fog during the morning hours. Partly cloudy skies can be expected for the afternoon. The marine layer will deepen further Saturday night into Sunday morning making low clouds and fog more widespread during the morning as the trough begins to move inland. Temperatures will be cooler with highs reaching the upper 50s to low 60s in the afternoon.
